The Ruby Valley Clinic was constructed in 1987 to serve the needs of the residents of the Ruby Valley. The clinic was approved by Medicare for rural health care status in 2003. The clinic has over 2500 visits per year.

The Twin Bridges Clinic was constructed in 1967 by the citizens of Twin Bridges for Dr. Bruce Beithon's practice. Dr. Beithon retired in 2002 and the Ruby Valley Hospital assumed responsibility for the clinic in 2003. The clinic sees over 1500 patients per year.
